CLUB PRESIDENTS REPORT – SEASON 2015

2015 has been a very successful year for HHRUFC both on and off the field, and the club has established a very firm foundation on which to build towards its 125th year in 2017.

The Senior Club had a tremendous year and they should be proud of their achievements. Despite losing in the Div 2 Final against the eventual premiers, the First Grade team provided genuine rugby entertainment at Boronia Park - with Cats Corner regularly packed to witness some of the best team efforts you will see. Some of the tries on offer were nothing short of spectacular, and their confidence and commitment this season is to be commended.

In all grades we had competitive teams, with 3 teams making the finals and strong numbers. We led the Club Championship for most of the season, and are positioned well for 2016.

We look forward to Rayne Simpson taking the reins in 2016 and continuing success

The Junior Club has another successful year – building on numbers from 2014, and undertaking some new innovations to broaden appeal to kids and parents alike:

- New Fee structures to encourage younger players trying Rugby for the first time;
- TryRugby for Under 5's was a big success;
- Friday Night Minis training was an excellent way to bring more club members together;
- 2 x Back to Boronia Nights – one of which coinciding with the Seniors Back to Boronia Day – making it a whole of club Back to Boronia Weekend;
- Hosting the Sydney Juniors Regional Carnival – which is arguably the best display of youth talent in Sydney all year.

Like all other Junior Rugby Clubs – there is increasing pressure on maintaining registrations, but the Junior Club is looking to address this with some well advanced plans for 2016 (such as School campaigns and a Junior Camp in March 2016).

I would like to call out to 2015 Junior Age Groups for special recognition:

- The **2015 Under 16 Age Group** completed their successful journey through HHRUFC with a number of premierships and many state champions in their ranks. This is arguably the most successful age group the HH has produced;
- The **2015 Under 15 Age Group** won their second premiership (U15 B Comp) in 3 years, and produced a staggering 7 representatives to the NSW U17 side. They were also extremely well coached.



The HH Golden Oldies (Cats) had a great year both on and off the field – although I would dare say that increased playing numbers are needed to ensure that this part of the club continues as a playing entity. Notwithstanding this the Cats have continued to make significant contributions to the club – from the new Club Flagpole at Boronia Park to their fashion statements on Cats Corner all season. I look forward to some of the great plans that the Cats have in store to provide continued support to the club in 2016. Special mention should be made of **Peter McFarlane** who personally drove many of the Cats initiatives, and achieved record registrations this year (clearly the ‘First Beer on Us’ promotion was popular).

The Club is blessed to have the hard working core of volunteers that make up the Archive Committee (TAC). This year the team have continued to mine the Club History – while at the same time focusing on digitizing the clubs archival records, with an aim to making them available online to club members. The TAC is a goldmine for this club, and we should continue to provide as much support as possible to ensure the enrichment of this unparalleled club asset.

On behalf of the Board of Management I would like to extend thanks to each of the hard working committees that are the lifeblood of Hunters Hill Rugby. Without their work in setting up fields, washing jerseys, filling water bottles, turning sausages and keeping Boronia Park clean – we simply would not be able to enjoy being part of this great club. In 2015 - I especially want to thank the Sub-Committee Treasurers (**Alan Evans, Gareth James, and Michael MacNamara**) who do probably the toughest and most thankless task in the Club – and in 2015 have done an excellent job in managing the clubs finances.

The Board has been extremely busy in 2016 with a number of key operational issues that affect the club:

HHRUFC Season Launch

The launch was successfully run by the Board for the first time in 2015, and generated over \$14,000 in revenue that was put to use in many necessary ‘All of Club’ investments. Note that the 2016 Season Launch is already booked for 18th March, 2016 – and is already expected to be a sell out;

Boronia Park Plan of Management (BP POM)

The required constant focus from the Board – with numerous online campaigns, signatures, meetings, emails and council consultations. We are close to a result here – with Ian Kellaway representing the club at the HH Council meeting that is considering the POM right now (literally). We look forward to hearing from Ian.

It is hoped that the revised POM will ensure the club can negotiate long term tenure in good faith with HH council, and also focus on many of the much needed developments across the precinct (such as B3 Drainage and an Amenities Block between B2 and B3).

We should expect that this process will drive increased engagement with both Council and other constituent groups – as above all this process has brought into focus the priceless asset of Boronia Park, and how we should (along with other users) fight hard to ensure it's preservation as a sporting Mecca in Sydney.

I would like to thank all for their contribution in our fight for Rugby at Boronia Park – in particular the Australian Rugby Union, NSWRU, NSW and Sydney Juniors, and other local clubs that have learnt their support.



Club Finances

2014 was a year that saw some poor financial management practices adopted by some aspects of the club, leading to a delay in the Annual AGM. I am pleased to report that this was 100% addressed in 2016, with moves to MYOB online, and complete transparency in our financial position.

The Board is particularly proud of being able to settle **all** inter-committee financial obligations, meaning that the ghosts of the B3 project can finally be put to rest. The club should feel very confident about our consolidated financial position as we look to the future.

Club Ties

Out of a very sad event in the funeral of Bruce 'Angry' Lycett came the realization that Club Ties were few but varied. The Board initiated the manufacture of a new club tie in 2015, and these are on sale now, and expected to sell heavily at the 2016 Club Season Launch.

Operations Manual

This artefact was developed in 2014, and is due for review by the incoming 2016 Board. It is an important document that sets out guidelines.

Club Infrastructure

The Board took responsibility for a number of small costs associated with all arms of the club. From Scrum Machine repairs, to miscellaneous Rubbish removals, to the Henley Rental – the Board is now in an ongoing position to ensure that the Sub Committees can get on with what happens on the field. That said – the Board intends to continue to have – where necessary – the subcommittees pay their way.

There are a number of projects that require focus in 2016, such as B3 Drainage, Goal Post storage, and future planning for club activities at Boronia Park.

Finally on this topic – it is my wish to see the Board maintain a small 'fighting fund' of around \$5K to be used on a 'rainy day'. Other than that – I see the Board as having no mandate to manage ongoing funds and should seek to invest in the broader club from year to year.

Thank You

To our Club Patrons (The Hon. Joe Hockey MP, the Hon. Anthony Roberts MP, and Gordon Bray) I wanted to say thank you for your support in 2015. Of particular note is **Gordon Bray** – who has volunteered his time at seven Club Season Launches – and makes it such a special Rugby Event. He also continues to support the club during the season – and will always be welcome at Cat Corner.

To **Ian Kellaway**, who is not only our Council Liaison Officer, but also our auditor – a big thank you! Kell continues to provide me great counsel at any time of the day or night – and is one of the rocks of this club. Thankyou Kell!

I wanted to thank the Club Sponsors – whose support is essential in being able to field both Senior and Junior teams each week. We continue to work hard to ensure that they see a return on their investment – and there is work going on now to see a continuation of these key relationships into 2016.

I would like to make special mention of my Board Colleagues – **Blake Walker**, **Connal Harvey** and **Glen Sanford**. This team do tireless work behind the scenes to keep the club moving forward, and allow the sub-committees to focus on their players and members. I have enjoyed working with each of you – and hope to see your continued involvement in the Board and Club in general.



Focus for 2016

With 2015 being a year to stabilise the running of the club after the tumult of the B3 Project, we have well and truly earned the right to look forward to the future. I would like to challenge the 2016 Board to commit to the following three themes for the coming season:

- Brand
- Unity
- Culture

Each of these areas require hard and constant work – and if we can make progress on them we are guaranteed that the club will be in a better place than when we started. With these foundations operating well – the on-field results will look after themselves.

In closing - as we approach the 125th year of the great club, I believe each of the playing arms of the club should be filled with optimism about what they can aspire to and achieve. We have a history that is the envy of any club, the best home ground in Australia, and a vibrant mix of members.....these are ingredients that you cannot buy!

Hunters Hill “Mostyn & Kellaway Shields” - Eligibility

The “Andrew Mostyn” Shield is awarded to the best performing, competitive team in the regular season of the junior AND senior clubs combined.

The “Ian Kellaway” Shield is awarded to the best performing, competitive team in the regular season in the junior club.

Teams eligible to participate in the Shields are teams registered with the Hunters Hill Rugby Union Football Club or Hunters Hill Junior Rugby Union Football Club involved in any full season, outdoor winter rugby competition administered by NSW Subbies or SJRU. (ie for juniors only includes from U10 and above)

Teams are eligible to only win one shield each season – ie the team that wins the “Andrew Mostyn” shield becomes ineligible for the “Ian Kellaway” and it shall be awarded to the next qualified team.

Hunters Hill “Club Shields” - Criteria

1. The Shield is awarded to the team which finishes the highest in its division during the regular season ie. before commencement of play-off rounds.

2. In the event that two or more teams finish in the same highest position eg. first, the winner is the team that earns the maximum percentage of competition (win/draw) points which are available to them during the regular season. Note: this excludes any bonus point system.

The maximum points available may vary depending on the number of teams in the competition draw therefore a review of the competition size is required to ensure that maximum points available from actual matches played ie. excluding byes, are the only ones included. (eg a team playing in a 6 team competition may play more games than a team in an 8 team competition providing the team with a greater opportunity to gain more total points). The calculation will be the number of wins (of games actually played) divided by the number of games played. Draws shall count as ½ of a win. This should be calculated as a percentage of the total points available calculated to 2 decimal places.

3. In the case where two or more teams obtain the same percentage of maximum points available the winner will be determined by:

a) The team with the highest points ratio (points for divided by points against); and if still equal

b) The team with the highest points differential from games played (points for minus points against) and if still equal

c) If still equal then - Declare the relevant team’s joint winners of Shield.

Chairman's Report - Juniors 2015

2015 saw the implementation of a few new ideas at Hunters Hill Junior Rugby.

The Club introduced

Age Group Training on the same evening

All teams from the age group trained on the same night. Most teams have done this for years but over the last couple in some age groups this rule has broken down causing communication and friction within age groups. It is now a club policy that all teams from an age group train on the same evening at the same time. This leads into.....

Aged Group Skill Based Training

The start of each Training session was to involve each Age Group being involved in skill based training for 30 minutes approximately as a whole. The idea was to increase the skill set of the age group, foster communication between all teams, coaches and managers within the age group and generally provide a place for all boys of whatever skill level to enjoy time with their friends even if they were in different teams. At Hunter Hill Juniors the committee would rather run "skinny teams" to maximise increase game time for its players but this takes a lot of co operation and communication between team management and what a better place to start than mid week training.

Friday Night Training for Minis

This year saw the start of Friday night training for the clubs mini's. With the canteen open and the ability for parents to feed their families conveniently and cheaply many families stayed for the duration of training creating a great atmosphere at Boronia leading into the Friday night games. This year the Under 9's still trained during the week but the committee feels that with this year's successful experiment all minis teams will train on Friday nights in 2016. The committee trialled a few new ideas this year

Following on from last year Back to Boronia Night had to be cancelled at the first attempt due to rain. Held later in the season, the night I believe was well received by all that attended. The idea behind the night is to bring together boys, siblings and parents from the whole junior club to enjoy a night of Rugby at Boronia. There was a jumping castle and the Archive Committee set up a tent displaying Junior and club history. As I stressed last year the committee would like to expand these nights to include Hunters Hill Rugby families that are no longer with the club or just do not play on Friday nights anymore.

Presentation Day (or Night)

Again this year the club held the Presentation on a Friday night once again the response was that it was a move for the better. The boys have a good time and the parents can feed the family and have a drink and it is all over on the Friday. This year it was also held the 1st Friday after Grand Final Sunday so Rugby was done and dusted well before the summer sports started.

This year also saw Hunters Hill Juniors return fully to the Gordon Minis Competition. This return saw a much better bringing together of the minis group as a whole with 4/5 Saturday mornings where all our minis teams were playing at Boronia. The reason for us moving some teams to the Inner West minis to support its growth in the first few years was no longer relevant as the Inner West mini competition was thriving. This allowed HH to return to Gordon and I believe saw a positive reaction from all parents and families thus a growth in the community feeling within the club. Many a Saturday at Boronia Rugby went from 8.00 am till 5.00 pm as the seniors followed the mini's.

What a better advertisement for the Hunters Hill Rugby Club.



As an attempt to make minis Rugby more attractive to the younger players the club decided to halve the registration fee for the Under 6's and 7's. This we will also carry through to 2016. The introduction of Try Rugby saw 18 under 5's at Boronia every Friday night lapping up the atmosphere and hopefully enjoying themselves. What 4/ 5 year old would not like to be running around park, under lights with a football in their hands.

In the 2015 Gordon minis Hunters Hill Juniors fielded

- 3 X Under 6's
- 2 X Under 7's
- 4 X Under 8's
- 4 X Under 9's teams.

Once again I would just like to thank Carolyn Swindell on behalf of the committee and parents for taking control of what is a very hard volunteer job and time consuming position. A lot of work goes into this and Carolyn has over the past two years has done the job expertly and professionally. A minis report will follow.

Ladies touch was again run on a Monday evening. There were 50 or so girls and mothers playing every Monday evening throughout the season and being fortunate to referee a few games was able to see the enjoyment all the players had over the season. After 12 Rounds

The final was played by the Goonies and the ThunderCats with the Goonies winning 9 – 6.

Once again the competition was organised and run by Ben Gregory with the help of Sam Dermody and Andrew Johnstone.

Regional weekend

Hunters Hill Juniors applied for and was granted hosting right for the 2015 Regional carnival on the July 11th/12th weekend Over the weekend 34 games of rugby were played at Boronia with teams from the 4 Sydney regions and some country teams over the 15's ,16's, 17's and 18's . There was also an Under 14's Sydney final trial played.

The organisation was done by Ben Gregory in his role of SJRU representative coordinator but Hunters Hill provided all the day facilities. Well done Ben. The weekend went well and the canteen had one of its biggest workouts over the two days. These weekend although a lot of work are profitable for the club and at the same time increase Hunters Hill Rugby's profile in the NSW Rugby community. Particular thanks also go to, Andrew Skelly, Ian Kellaway, Bonnie Gregory and Adam Latham for their work over the weekend in helping us run the tournament. Many thanks.

REGISTRARS REPORT 2015

Total number of registrations for HHJRUFVC was 403 for the 2015 season. This was a small increase on last year, and only 83% of registrations compared to 2013. The registrations for the past six years has been as follows:

In 2015, we saw the return of an U13 Cerise team. The U15 were able to field two teams this year, a HH Black side and a Barbarians side with Drummoyne. This year the U16/U17's formed two Barbarians sides with Mosman.

Across the Club, Age Group numbers seemed consistent with the previous year. The only exception being the U11s, who lost roughly a quarter of their group. This year's U11s had some issues early in the season with its Age Group Coordinator. I would recommend asking Ross Nassif for his opinions on this group and any recommendations he might have for the future.

Last year I highlighted concerns with our low minis numbers. The Club introduced a number of initiatives to try to boost our numbers of young members.

1. U5 TryRugby was introduced for the first time. We saw 18 preschoolers sign up for the program, and two of these "players" ended their season with U6 teams.
2. All Minis trained on Friday nights. This appears to have been a big success, and really helped with our community spirit.
3. We moved the Minis completely to the Gordon competition.
4. We ran a special promotion for our U6 and U7 offering them half price registration (\$50).

U12 Hong Kong Tour 2015

The U12 Hong Kong Tour was a big success. It will be interesting to see if it helps entice boys/families in the current U11s to remain with the Club, and if it helps encourage the current U12 to stick with HHJRU when they move into High School next year.

Ladies Touch Competition

It took a while to get the Ladies Touch Competition up this year. But it was a great success once it was up and running. There were 6 teams this year, with about 50 players.



Registration Fees

Registration fees were raised for some age groups this year:

U5 TryRugby	\$50
U6-U7	\$50 (technically, \$100 for 2015 with a 50% discount, \$80 in 2013)
U8-U9	\$200 (up from \$180 in 2014)
U10-U12	\$225 (up from \$200 in 2014, \$180 in 2013)
U13-U16	\$225 (up from \$200 in 2014, \$180 in 2013)
U17-U18	\$225 (up from \$200 in 2014, \$180 in 2013)

All age groups had a \$30 discount for 2nd and subsequent players.

Hardship cases were judged by the Age Coordinator, and were expected to contribute half of the registration fee.

Ladies \$50

I recommend holding our registration fees steady for 2016, as we have increased them the past two years running.

I would also like to see the U6/U7 registration fee remain at the promotion level of \$50. However, it doesn't appear to have increased our U6/U7 registration numbers this year.

Treasurers Report - Seniors 2015

The 2015 season saw mixed results in the finances of the club. Overall, the year was a success with the Seniors being able to retire some old debts, however this has resulted in the cupboard being a little bare at the end of the year. This is, of course, a point from which we can build for the future.

Looking at the Statement of Income and Expenditure for the year, it can be seen that total income (net of GST) fell by 15% from \$92,481 to \$78,187. This is a combination of the loss of a few home games due to the shorter season, and an expected drop in sponsorships due to the amateur status in 2015.

Expenses for the year totaled \$76,106, a fall of 22% over the previous year. The major items contributing to this were:-

- Affiliation and registration fees – NSWSRU has upped the fees for Subbies clubs by 80%, presumably to help pay the ARU deficit?
- Ground hire and markings – this year the costs were spread between the seniors and the juniors, whereas in past years the juniors picked up the marking bill.
- Total phsio costs actually dropped from \$8,077 to \$6,243, with the physio's supplying their own strapping.

There are a few items that I think warrant particular attention:-

- First and foremost, our sponsors have again come to the party with their support. The committee, and the club as a whole, wish to express profound gratitude to these people and remind you to support our sponsors at every opportunity:-
 - Bayview Hotel
 - Astute Advertising
 - Craig & Rhodes
 - Andy Mostyn
 - Rozelle Glass/Mark Thornton

Although the third largest income generator, player fees received were extremely disappointing. It appears that many members do not feel obliged to pay their membership fees, leaving their colleagues to fund their season. With insurance, ground hire, team kits, ground marking and other player related costs, it costs approximately \$360 per player to put Hillies on the field this year. As you can see the \$250 per player (\$150 per Colt) doesn't cover these costs, so if you don't pay your fees these costs have to be paid out of other club income, which should in fact be going towards building a healthier club financial position. If anyone feels that they may be exempt from paying fees, don't! No-one is exempt, period. Please remember this in 2016.

The canteen was again a mainstay of income, and for this our thanks must go to Pam, and her able assistants including Glenys, Ann, Di, Brooke and Tash. It should be understood that your weekly beers and sausage sangers do not just magically appear in your hands. There is much work to be done before and after each game, and again, it takes many hands. There may be some members who hold their RSA (a requirement for selling alcohol) and may be able to assist at home games. If we get numbers up, then each "volunteer" need only do a few hours every other home game, so please consider it. If you don't have your



RSA, and would like to assist, let me know – the club may be able to help you out with your RSA course fee, it's only a few hours for a life time of fun. If you feel you can help next season please send me an email and I'll put you on a list.

Socially, the club did not have a great year. Although some functions were arranged, there is more that can be done. In this regard, please keep in mind that your committee will welcome all suggestions, no matter how out there they may seem, along with any offers to assist. For your club to be successful on the field, it should be also successful off.

It is appropriate that I mention a few others whose efforts contributed to the financial result for the year.

Matt Macrae and Sunjay Jain were (almost) tireless in chasing player fees, possibly the most disliked task in the club. Can everyone please remember that it is very important that all players pay their fees.

Although the results weren't always financially favorable, Tim Forsyth put his hand up for a few functions during the season. And, Lisa Croucher will long be remembered for a very enjoyable Presentation Night. For the club to be successful, more people have to do just this.

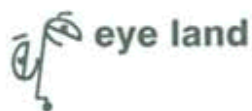
